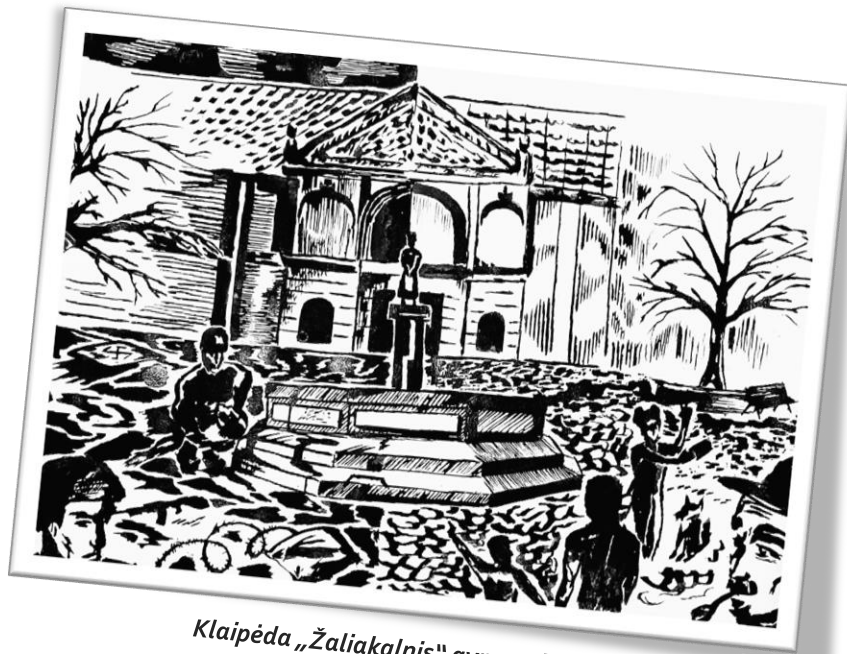
The core idea for Tolerance

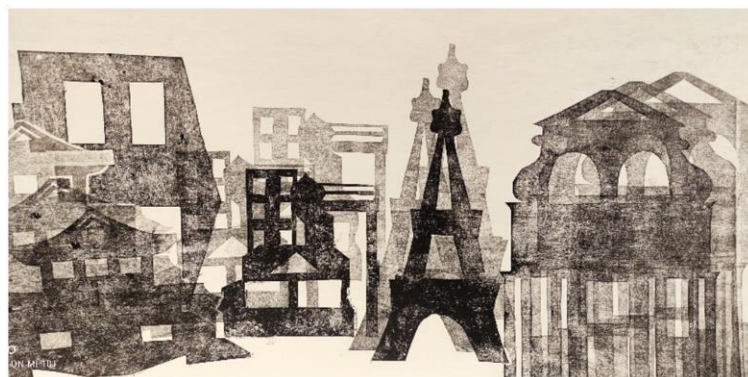
